## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

An Act further regulating Appropriations by the School Committee of the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section two of chapter two hundred  
2 and six of the special acts of nineteen hundred and  
3 nineteen is hereby amended by striking out all after  
4 the word "mayor" in the fifth line, — so as to read  
5 as follows: — *Section 2.* The votes of the school com-  
6 mittee making appropriations as aforesaid shall have  
7 the same force and effect as orders or votes of the city  
8 council appropriating money, and shall be subject to  
9 the same provisions of law in respect to approval by  
10 the mayor.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
