Resolutions on the Death of Calvin Coolidge.

Resolved, That the Massachusetts House of Representatives, in which the late Calvin Coolidge served so efficiently, hereby records its appreciation of his sagacity, clarity of thought, brevity and forcefulness of utterance, qualities whose manifestation rendered more notable his long public service for the city of Northampton, Hampshire County, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the United States of America, and also its profound respect for him, as a man as well as a public servant; and be it further

Resolved, That these Resolutions be spread upon the records of the House, and that an engrossed copy be transmitted by the Speaker thereof, attested by the Clerk, to the family of Mr. Coolidge.
