The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act abolishing the Sewer Commission of the City of
Taunton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sewer commission of the city of
2 Taunton, established under the provisions of chapter
3 two hundred and nineteen of the acts of eighteen hun-
4 dred and ninety-five, is hereby abolished and all the
5 powers, duties and obligations of said commission are
6 hereby transferred to and shall hereafter be vested in
7 and imposed on the municipal council of said city, who
8 shall in all respects be the legal successors of said com-
9 mission.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
