An Act authorizing Certain Persons to Fish in Lake Cochituate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 It shall be lawful for any inhabitant of the town of
2 Framingham, Natick or Wayland to fish in the waters
3 of Lake Cochituate, subject to such reasonable regu-
4 lations as may be made by the metropolitan district
5 commission. Any person violating any regulation
6 made hereunder shall be punished by a fine of not
7 more than twenty dollars and may be suspended from
8 the right to fish as aforesaid for such time as the com-
9 mission may deem reasonable and just.
