

HOUSE No. 528

By Mr. Halliwell of New Bedford, petition of the Massachusetts State Federation of Labor that the words "time so lost" as used in the laws relative to compensating employees injured in industrial accidents be defined to mean time lost voluntarily by employees. Labor and Industries.

An Act defining Lost Time.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one of chapter one hundred and fifty-two of
2 the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
3 after paragraph (1) the following:— (1A) Lost time,
4 or "time so lost" as used in the preceding paragraph,
5 shall mean time voluntarily lost by the employee, and
6 shall not include the time lost by an act of God or
7 involuntary loss of opportunity for employment or by
8 any condition over which the employee had no con-
9 trol.
