By Mr. Swenson of Cambridge (by request), petition of Richard M. Russell, mayor of Cambridge, that two employees in the office of any city auditor be exempted from the civil service laws. Civil Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

An Act exempting from Civil Service Two Employees of
the City Auditor of Any City.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section five of chapter thirty-one of
2 the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
3 after the first word "city" in the thirteenth line the
4 words:— two employees of the city auditor of any
5 city, — so as to read as follows:— *Section 5.* No rule
6 by the board shall apply to the election or appoint-
7 ment of any of the following:

8 Judicial officers; officers elected by the people or,
9 except as otherwise expressly provided in this chapter,
10 by a city council; officers whose appointment is sub-
11 ject to confirmation by the executive council, or by
12 the city council of any city; officers whose appoint-
13 ment is subject to the approval of the governor and
14 council; officers elected by either branch of the gen-
15 eral court and the appointees of such officers; heads

16 of principal departments of the commonwealth or of
17 a city; directors of divisions authorized by law in the
18 departments of the commonwealth; employees of the
19 state treasurer appointed under section five of chapter
20 ten, employees of the commissioner of banks, and of
21 the treasurer and collector of taxes of any city; two
22 employees of the city auditor of any city; two em-
23 ployees of the city clerk of any city; public school
24 teachers; secretaries and confidential stenographers
25 of the governor, or of the mayor of any city; police
26 and fire commissioners and chiefs and chief marshals
27 of police and fire departments, except as provided in
28 section forty-nine; and such others as are by law
29 exempt from the operation of this chapter.

1 SECTION 2. This act as amended shall not affect
2 present employees in the auditing department of any
3 city.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
