By Mr. Clemons of Wakefield, petition of Maynard E. S. Clemons that hearings and reviews be abolished when reduction of compensation of public employees is made on grounds of economy only. Civil Service.

An Act relating to Hearings and Reviews under Civil Service Laws.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter thirty-one of the General Laws (Tercen-
2 tenary edition) is hereby amended by inserting
3 after section fifty the following new section:—

4 *Section 50A.* Nothing in this chapter shall entitle
5 a person to a hearing or a review on the lowering of
6 his compensation when the order therefor states
7 that the lowering is made on the ground of economy
8 and not because of charges.
