The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

An Act placing the Office of Chief of the Fire Department of the City of Everett under the Civil Service Laws.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The office of the chief of the fire department of
2 the city of Everett, shall upon the effective date of
3 this act become subject to the civil service laws and
4 rules and regulations relating to the appointment
5 and removal of fire chiefs in cities who have accepted
6 the civil service acts, provided however, that James
7 Evans the present incumbent of said office, may
8 continue to serve as such without taking a civil
9 service examination.
