An Act relative to the Designation of Deputy Sheriffs to serve as Court Officers in the Superior Court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section sixty-nine of chapter two hundred and  
2 twenty-one of the General Laws, as appearing in  
3 the Tercentenary edition thereof, is hereby amended  
4 by adding at the end thereof the following new sen-  
5 tence:— No deputy sheriff shall be designated to  
6 serve as a court officer in any sitting of the superior  
7 court for civil or criminal business except with the  
8 approval of the justices thereof.
