The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

An Act to permit the Trapping of Vermin and Fur-bearing Animals by Ordinary Means where Such Trapping is not Otherwise Permitted.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section one hundred and five A of chapter one
- 2 hundred and thirty-one of the General Laws is hereby
- 3 repealed.
