The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

Resolve providing for an Investigation of the Rates charged by Fire Insurance Companies.

1 *Resolved*, That a special joint committee, consisting
2 of one member of the senate to be designated by the
3 president thereof and three members of the house of
4 representatives to be designated by the speaker
5 thereof, is hereby authorized to sit during the recess
6 of the general court to investigate the general subject
7 of rates charged by fire insurance companies. Said
8 committee may hold hearings and shall be provided
9 with quarters at the state house and may expend for
10 expert, clerical and other services and expenses such
11 sums, not exceeding, in the aggregate,
12 dollars, as may hereafter be appropriated. Said com-
13 mittee shall report to the general court the results of
14 its investigation and study, and its recommendations,
15 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry
16 its recommendations into effect, by filing the same
17 with the clerk of the house of representatives not later
18 than December thirty-first in the current year.
