## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

An Act authorizing the City of Boston to compensate Certain Persons whose Property was Damaged by the Explosion of Dynamite used in Connection with Sewer Construction in Said City.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a  
2 moral obligation the city of Boston may pay to  
3 persons whose property located in Hinsdale road  
4 and Edgemere road in the West Roxbury District  
5 of said city was damaged by the explosion of dyna-  
6 mite used in connection with sewer construction,  
7 such sums not exceeding in the aggregate twenty  
8 thousand dollars, as may be determined by the legal  
9 department of said city and approved by the mayor.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 acceptance during the current year by vote of the  
3 city council of said city, subject to the provisions  
4 of its charter, but not otherwise.
