





2 proval of the commissioners, may issue temporary  
3 notes of the county, payable in not more than one  
4 year from their dates, in anticipation of the issue of  
5 serial bonds or notes under the preceding section, but  
6 the time within which such serial bonds or notes shall  
7 become due and payable shall not, by reason of such  
8 temporary notes, be extended beyond the time fixed  
9 by said section. Any notes issued in anticipation of  
10 the serial bonds or notes shall be paid from the pro-  
11 ceeds thereof.

1 SECTION 4. For the purpose of meeting the pay-  
2 ments required to be made by the town of Scituate  
3 under this act, said town may borrow from time to  
4 time such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding  
5 in the aggregate, and may issue notes  
6 therefor, which shall bear on their face the words,  
7 "Town of Scituate, Sea Wall Loan, Act of 1933".  
8 Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate  
9 loan, and such loans shall be paid within five years  
10 from their dates. Indebtedness incurred by said  
11 town under this act shall be in excess of the statutory  
12 limit, but shall, except as herein provided, be subject  
13 to chapter forty-four of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 5. This act shall take full effect upon its  
2 acceptance during the current year by vote of the  
3 county commissioners of Plymouth county and by  
4 vote of the town of Scituate in town meeting and the  
5 filing in the office of the said department of certified  
6 copies of said votes. So much thereof as provides for  
7 acceptance as aforesaid shall take effect upon its  
8 passage.
