Resolve providing for an Investigation by the Department of Public Utilities relative to the Erection and Maintenance of Protective Devices at Railroad Crossings, Drawbridges and Other Locations.

1    *Resolved*, That the department of public utilities is  
2 hereby authorized and directed to investigate the  
3 subject matter of current house document number  
4 three hundred and eighty-six relative to the erection  
5 and maintenance of protective devices at railroad  
6 crossings, drawbridges and other locations. Said  
7 department shall report to the general court the  
8 results of its investigations, and its recommendations,  
9 if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary  
10 to carry the same into effect by filing the same with  
11 the clerk of the house of representatives on or before  
12 December first in the current year.
