An Act placing the Office of Chief of the Fire Department of the Town of Weymouth under the Civil Service Laws.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The office of chief of the fire de-
2 partment of the town of Weymouth shall, upon the
3 effective date of this act, become subject to the civil
4 service laws and rules and regulations relating to
5 the permanent members of the fire departments of
6 towns, and the tenure of office of any incumbent
7 thereof shall be unlimited, except that he may be
8 removed in accordance with such laws and rules
9 and regulations; but the person holding said office
10 on said effective date may continue to serve as such
11 without taking a civil service examination.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
