

HOUSE No. 1348

Mr. Cahill of Braintree presented a petition of Horace T. Cahill for legislation to authorize conveyance by the Commonwealth to the United States of America of a tract of land in Petersburg, Virginia, and the Massachusetts military monument located thereon. Ways and Means (Joint).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

An Act authorizing the Conveyance to the United States of America of a Tract of Land in Petersburg, Virginia, and the Massachusetts Military Monument located thereon.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For the purpose of transferring to the United
2 States of America for incorporation in the Petersburg
3 National Military Park, which is being established
4 under an act of congress approved July third, nine-
5 teen hundred and twenty-six, the tract of land owned
6 by the commonwealth in Petersburg, Virginia, and
7 the Massachusetts military monument erected thereon
8 under the provisions of chapter seventy-two of the
9 resolves of nineteen hundred and ten, the governor
10 and council are hereby authorized, on behalf of the

11 commonwealth, to convey to the United States of
12 America said tract of land and military monument,
13 with the provision that the United States of America
14 shall maintain property so transferred without expense
15 to the commonwealth.
