Resolve providing for an Investigation relative to Spot Pond Brook in the Town of Stoneham and Cities of Melrose and Malden.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public health and
2 the metropolitan district commission, acting as a joint
3 board, are hereby authorized and directed to investi-
4 gate the matter of improving Spot Pond brook, so
5 called, in the town of Stoneham, city of Melrose and
6 city of Malden, from its source at Doleful pond, in the
7 Middlesex Fells reservation in the said town of Stone-
8 ham to the Malden river in the said city of Malden.
9 In connection with said investigation, said board shall
10 consult with the appropriate officials of said cities and
11 town and shall consider the reports relative to said
12 brook submitted to the general court under the pro-
13 visions of chapter one hundred of the resolves of nine-
14 teen hundred and thirteen and chapter fifty of the
15 resolves of nineteen hundred and fourteen, and all
16 plans and data compiled by the officials who sub-
17 mitted said reports. Said board shall report to the
18 general court its findings and its recommendations,
19 if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to
20 carry its recommendations into effect and estimates of
21 the probable cost of any improvements recommended
22 by it, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of
23 representatives on or before December first in the
24 current year.
