## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

An Act authorizing the Town of Fairhaven to hold a Special Town Election for the Filling of Certain Vacancies Simultaneously with the Special State Election to be held on June Thirteenth in the Current Year.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of filling a vacancy in  
2 its board of selectmen, its board of public welfare  
3 and its planning board, for the unexpired terms, the  
4 town of Fairhaven is hereby authorized to hold a  
5 special town election on June thirteenth in the cur-  
6 rent year simultaneously with the special state  
7 election to be held on said date and at the same polling  
8 places; but separate ballots, ballot boxes, check lists  
9 and election officers shall be used for the election of  
10 said town officers and otherwise said special town  
11 election shall be held and conducted in the same  
12 manner as an annual town meeting.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
