## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

An Act regulating the Operation of Vehicles traveling in  
the Same Direction.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter eighty-nine of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out section two, as appearing in  
3 the Tercentenary edition thereof, and inserting in  
4 place thereof the following:—

5 *Section 2.* The driver of a vehicle passing another  
6 vehicle traveling in the same direction shall drive a  
7 safe distance to the left of such other vehicle; and, if  
8 the way is of sufficient width for the two vehicles to  
9 pass, the driver of the leading one shall not unneces-  
10 sarily obstruct the other.
