

HOUSE No. 1561

By Mr. Cahill of Braintree, petition of Charles A. Stevens and Horace T. Cahill relative to application of moneys received by the Commonwealth under the federal emergency relief act of the current year. Joint Ways and Means and Municipal Finance (sitting jointly).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

An Act relative to the Application of Moneys received by the Commonwealth under the Federal Emergency Relief Act of Nineteen Hundred and Thirty-three.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would
2 tend to defeat its purpose, therefore it is hereby de-
3 clared to be an emergency law, necessary for the im-
4 mediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section eight of chapter three hundred and seven
2 of the acts of the current year, being an act entitled
3 "An Act authorizing cities and towns to borrow on
4 account of public welfare and soldiers' benefits from
5 the commonwealth and elsewhere and authorizing
6 the commonwealth to issue bonds or notes to provide
7 funds therefor", is hereby repealed.
