## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Three.

An Act providing for Enlarging the Swansea Fire and Water District.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The inhabitants of the town of Swan-  
2 sea residing in that part of the town of Swansea  
3 bounded and described as follows: beginning at the  
4 Massachusetts-Rhode Island state line where such  
5 line is intersected by a line parallel to and five hun-  
6 dred feet west of the center line of Seaview avenue;  
7 thence running northerly in said line parallel to and  
8 five hundred feet west of the center line of Seaview  
9 avenue to a point five hundred feet south of the  
10 center line of Davis street; thence running westerly  
11 parallel to and five hundred feet south of the center  
12 line of Davis street extended and continuing in the  
13 same direction to a point five hundred feet west of  
14 the center line of Touisset avenue; thence running  
15 northerly parallel to and five hundred feet west of the

16 center line of Touisset avenue to the highway known  
17 under the contemplated name of Barton avenue;  
18 thence running to a point on the right of way of the  
19 New York, New Haven & Hartford Railroad Company,  
20 lessee, five hundred feet west of the center line of River  
21 road where it is crossed by said railroad; thence in  
22 a line always five hundred feet from the center line  
23 of said River road to a point five hundred feet west  
24 of the center line of Pearse road; thence running  
25 northerly five hundred feet from and parallel to the  
26 center line of Pearse road to a point one thousand  
27 feet north of Wilbur avenue; thence running easterly  
28 always one thousand feet from and parallel to the  
29 center line of Wilbur avenue to the channel of Cole's  
30 river; thence generally southerly by the channel of  
31 Cole's river to the Massachusetts-Rhode Island  
32 state line; thence in a westerly direction to the point  
33 of beginning, — is added to and included in and  
34 constitutes a part of the Swansea fire and water  
35 district.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 acceptance by a majority vote of the voters of said  
3 district present and voting thereon at a duly called  
4 district meeting.
