## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act making the Provisions of the Civil Service Laws  
Applicable to the Town of Stoneham.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter thirty-one  
2 of the General Laws, except so much of section five  
3 as relates to employees of a city clerk, treasurer and  
4 collector of taxes of a city, and the rules made there-  
5 under, including those relative to the employment of  
6 laborers designated as the "labor service", shall be  
7 in force in the town of Stoneham.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
