MEMORANDUM OF COMMISSIONER OF CORPORATIONS AND TAXATION ACCOMPANYING PETITION TO THE GENERAL COURT BY JACOB J. KAPLAN TO EMPOWER THE HOME FOR JEWISH CHILDREN TO TRANSFER ITS PROPERTY TO THE JEWISH CHILD WELFARE ASSOCIATION, PURSUANT TO G. L. c. 3, § 7.

December 4, 1933.

To the Honorable Senate and the House of Representatives.

The above-named petition was seasonably deposited with me on October 31, 1933.

The Home for Jewish Children was organized April 9, 1909, as The Home for Destitute Jewish Children, Inc., under chapter 125 of the Revised Laws. It assumed its present name November 5, 1912. For an act affecting this corporation see chapter 113 of the Acts of 1912.

The Jewish Child Welfare Association was organized February 2, 1922, as The Jewish Children's Bureau of Boston, Inc., under chapter 180 of the General Laws. It assumed its present title March 29, 1933. For an act affecting this corporation see chapter 162 of the Acts of 1922.

The object of the petition is to empower the Home for Jewish Children to transfer its property to The Jewish Child Welfare Association, and in my opinion the object cannot be accomplished under the General Laws but requires legislation.

No fee is required.

Petition of Jacob J. Kaplan that the Home for Jewish Children be authorized to transfer its property to the Jewish Child Welfare Association. Mercantile Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act empowering the Home for Jewish Children to transfer its Property to the Jewish Child Welfare Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Home for Jewish Children, incor-
2 porated under general law, is hereby empowered to
3 transfer, assign, set over, and convey all funds and
4 property held by it to the Jewish Child Welfare Asso-
5 ciation, incorporated under general law, and the
6 Jewish Child Welfare Association is hereby empowered
7 to receive the same and to hold, manage and dispose
8 of all such funds and property charged with any
9 trust, upon the same trusts, uses and purposes as if
10 the same had continued to be held by the said Home
11 for Jewish Children for the fulfillment of the charitable
12 purposes of said corporation.

1 SECTION 2. The power hereby granted shall be
2 exercised only in conformity with such a decree, if

3 any, of the supreme judicial court, sitting in equity
4 for the county of Suffolk, as may be entered within
5 one year after the passage of this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall not take effect until it
2 shall have been accepted by the votes of the board of
3 directors, or the officers having the powers of directors,
4 of each of said corporations and copies of the respec-
5 tive votes of acceptance shall have been filed with
6 the secretary of the commonwealth.
