Accompanying the third recommendation of the Secretary of the Commonwealth (House, No. 137). Highways and Motor Vehicles.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act providing for the Removal by Surveyors of Highways and Road Commissioners of Political Posters or Cards attached to Trees or Structures adjacent to Public Ways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section seven of chapter eighty-four of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary
3 edition thereof, is hereby amended by inserting after
4 the word "convenient", in the fifth line, the words:
5 — They shall also remove or cause to be removed
6 all political posters or cards attached to trees, posts
7 or structures on or adjacent to the highway within
8 thirty days after the primary or election to which
9 they appertain.
