The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act regulating the Dispensing of Medicine and Physicians' Prescriptions by Druggists.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 No prescription shall be dispensed by any per-
2 son, except a registered pharmacist, an assistant
3 registered, or an apprentice under the supervision
4 of one of the above registered pharmacists, except a
5 physician, in an emergency, at the bedside, under
6 the same conditions as pertain to the administration
7 of narcotics, and in towns and villages in which
8 there is no store with a registered pharmacist in
9 attendance.
