## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act authorizing the Issuance of Temporary Licenses to Insurance Agents pending Examination for their Qualifications.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section one hundred and sixty-three of chapter one  
2 hundred and seventy-five of the General Laws is  
3 hereby amended by inserting after the word "therein",  
4 in the eleventh line, the following two new sen-  
5 tences:—

6 If the company so requests in the notice the com-  
7 missioner shall issue forthwith to such person a tem-  
8 porary license, subject to the provisions of this sec-  
9 tion governing licenses, for a period of forty-five days,  
10 pending a determination by the commissioner of the  
11 suitability and competency of such person to be  
12 granted a license as herein provided. No person  
13 holding such temporary license shall negotiate any  
14 policy of insurance, the premium for which is not

15 payable in monthly or more frequent instalments,  
16 nor shall any company issue any policy negotiated  
17 by any person holding a temporary license, unless the  
18 premium for such policy is payable monthly or more  
19 frequent instalments.
