## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

---

An Act abolishing the Board of Tax Appeals, and conferring upon the Several Boards of County Commissioners the Powers and Duties of Said Board of Tax Appeals.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Sections one to five, inclusive, of chapter fifty-
- 2 eight A of the General Laws are hereby repealed.
- 3 All provisions of the remaining sections of said
- 4 chapter, as amended, relative to the powers and
- 5 duties of the board of tax appeals shall, so far as
- 6 applicable, apply to the proper board of county
- 7 commissioners from and after the effective date of
- 8 this act.
