By Mr. Cohen of Boston, petition of B. Ralph Slobodkin for legislation to clarify the law prohibiting reckless driving of motor vehicles. Legal Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act further defining the Charge of Reckless Driving.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter ninety, section twenty-four, of the Gen-
2 eral Laws is hereby amended by striking out therein
3 line three thereof after the word "liquor" the words
4 "or negligently so that the",—by striking out in
5 line four of the said section the words "lives or
6 safety of the public might be endangered,"—so that
7 lines one, two, three and four of section twenty-four,
8 chapter ninety, will read as follows:—Whoever
9 upon any way, or any place to which the public has
10 a right to access, operates a motor vehicle recklessly,
11 or while under the influence of intoxicating liquor,
12 or upon a bet or wager, etc.
