

HOUSE No. 834

By Mr. Tobin of Salem, petition of James F. Tobin that cities and towns be prohibited from establishing ordinances or by-laws against parking of motor vehicles on public ways near public beaches. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

An Act permitting Parking of Motor Vehicles near
Public Beaches.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter ninety of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section twenty-seven the
3 following new section:—

4 *Section 27A.* No city or town shall prohibit the
5 parking of motor vehicles on any part of any public
6 way which is within one fourth of a mile of any public
7 beach. Any city or town ordinance, by-law or regu-
8 lation which violates this section shall be null and
9 void.
