

HOUSE No. 1007

By Mr. Bourgeois of Lowell, petition of Albert L. Bourgeois that persons engaged in the manufacture and sale of ice cream be authorized to purchase alcoholic beverages in wholesale quantities. Legal Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act authorizing Persons engaged in the Manufacture and Sale of Ice Cream to purchase Alcoholic Beverages in Wholesale Quantities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty-eight of chapter one hundred and
2 thirty-eight of the General Laws, as appearing in
3 section two of chapter three hundred and seventy-
4 six of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-three,
5 is hereby amended by inserting after the word “com-
6 monwealth” in the sixth line the words:—and
7 persons engaged in the manufacture and sale of ice
8 cream,— so as to read as follows:— *Section 28.*
9 The holder of a license under section eighteen or
10 nineteen may sell alcoholic beverages to churches
11 and religious societies, educational institutions li-
12 censed under section fourteen, incorporated hospitals
13 and homes for aged people whose real or personal

14 property is exempt from taxation under the laws of
15 the commonwealth and persons engaged in the manu-
16 facture and sale of ice cream, in such quantities
17 and subject to such restrictions as the commission
18 may by regulation prescribe. The holder of such a
19 license may also sell and deliver such beverages to
20 any person on any federal or state military or naval
21 reservation authorized by the commanding officer
22 thereof to purchase and receive the same.
