The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

Resolve in Favor of the Children of William P. Hogan.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging
2 a moral obligation, there be paid from the treasury
3 of the commonwealth, to the guardian of the de-
4 pendent minor children of William P. Hogan, who
5 was killed at West Acton, July eighth, nineteen
6 hundred and twenty-three, while in the performance
7 of his duty as a member of the one hundred and
8 first field artillery of the state military forces, an-
9 nually for the further term of three years, the sum
10 of one thousand dollars. All sums so paid shall
11 be expended by said guardian for the maintenance
12 and education of said children.
