

HOUSE No. 1191

By Mr. Dorgan of Boston, petition of Thomas Dorgan for further legislation relative to sale of certain alcoholic beverages by registered pharmacists. Legal Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act relative to the Sale of Certain Alcoholic Beverages.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter three hundred and seventy-six of the acts
2 of nineteen hundred and thirty-three is hereby
3 amended by striking out section thirty A and insert-
4 ing in place thereof the following:—

5 *Section 30A.* A registered pharmacist in a city or
6 town wherein the granting of licenses to sell alcohol
7 and alcoholic liquors is authorized may be licensed by
8 local licensing authorities to sell alcohol and alcoholic
9 liquors for medicinal purposes, only upon a phy-
10 sician's prescription, and may be authorized to sell
11 alcohol for mechanical or chemical purposes without
12 a physician's prescription, provided, however, that
13 such alcohol sold for mechanical or chemical purposes
14 has been medicated.
