## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act authorizing the Taking by Eminent Domain for the Purpose of a Site for a Fire and Police Station Building of Land within the Limits of Foster Street in the Town of Saugus.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The board of selectmen of the town  
2 of Saugus may take on behalf of said town by emi-  
3 nent domain under chapter seventy-nine of the  
4 General Laws as amended and under authority of a  
5 vote passed on December eighteen, nineteen hun-  
6 dred and thirty-three, at a special town meeting of  
7 said town, for the purpose of a site for a fire and  
8 police station building, the land included within the  
9 limits of such portion of the way in said town known  
10 as Foster street as lies between Taylor street and  
11 Woodbury avenue.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
