Resolve authorizing the Commissioner of Education to Release Easements in Certain State Land in the Town of Framingham.

1   *Resolved*, That the commissioner of education, with  
2 the approval of the governor and council, upon such  
3 terms, conditions and considerations as said commis-  
4 sioner, with like approval, may determine, is hereby  
5 authorized to release in whole or in part, on behalf of  
6 the commonwealth, by instrument or instruments  
7 approved by the attorney general, any easement for  
8 the construction and maintenance of a well, windmill  
9 and pipe line for supplying water to the state teachers  
10 college in the town of Framingham and referred to in  
11 an instrument dated March twentieth, eighteen hun-  
12 dred and seventy-six and recorded in Middlesex  
13 South District Registry of Deeds, Book 1388, Page  
14 166.
