## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

---

An Act providing for the Construction of a Certain Beach on the Malden River in the City of Everett and the Construction and Maintenance of a Bath House Thereat.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to construct a beach on the  
3 Malden river in the city of Everett near the Revere  
4 beach parkway and to construct and maintain at  
5 said beach a public bath house. For said purposes,  
6 said commission may expend such sums as may  
7 hereafter be appropriated therefor which shall be  
8 included in the amount to be assessed upon the  
9 metropolitan parks district for maintenance of reser-  
10 vations.
