By Mr. Dewar of Malden, petition of Burt Dewar, John V. Kimball and William H. Doyle that the city of Malden be authorized to pension John Cullen who was formerly employed in the building department in said city. Pensions.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act authorizing the City of Malden to pension John Cullen.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Malden may pay a pen-
2 sion of eight hundred and fifty dollars a year, payable
3 in equal monthly instalments, to John Cullen, a
4 former employee of said city in its building depart-
5 ment and now incapacitated and unfit for further
6 service by reason of injuries received while so em-
7 ployed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance during the current year by vote of the
3 city council of said city, subject to the provisions of
4 its charter.
