The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act enlarging the Powers and Duties of the License Commission in the City of Revere.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause (9) of section thirty-four of chapter six hun-
2 dred and eighty-seven of the acts of nineteen hundred
3 and fourteen is hereby amended by adding at the end
4 thereof the following new paragraph: —

5 The authority now vested by law in cities or towns
6 or in the city of Revere or any official thereof, to grant,
7 suspend or revoke any of the licenses hereinafter men-
8 tioned shall be exercised in said city by said commis-
9 sion exclusively. This section shall affect the follow-
10 ing licenses only: — To be innholders or common vic-
11 tuallers; to sell at retail any alcoholic beverages, as
12 defined in section one of chapter one hundred and
13 thirty-eight of the General Laws, the sale of which is
14 authorized in said city; to maintain lodging houses,
15 public lodging houses, intelligence offices, coffee

16 houses or tea houses, or vehicles for the sale of food in a
17 public way; to be collectors of, dealers in or keepers of
18 shops for the purchase, sale or barter of junk, old
19 metals or second hand articles; to engage in the busi-
20 ness of buying, selling, exchanging or assembling of
21 second hand motor vehicles or parts thereof; to carry
22 on the business of pawnbrokers; to sell, rent or lease
23 firearms; to establish, let, keep open and maintain a
24 grove to be used for picnics or other lawful gatherings
25 and amusements for hire, gain or reward; to retail
26 dealers to keep open their place of business on the
27 Lord's day for the sale of ice cream, confectionery,
28 soda water or fruit; to engage in the business of con-
29 ducting or maintaining an open-air space for the park-
30 ing for hire of more than three automobiles; and any
31 other license, authority to grant which, being thereto-
32 fore vested in the mayor, is by him delegated from
33 time to time to said commission.
