

HOUSE No. 1439

By Mr. Levins of Boston, petition of Francis E. Kelly that the city of Boston be authorized to borrow money for the purpose of establishing a municipal lighting plant. Municipal Finance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act authorizing the City of Boston to Establish and Construct a Municipal Lighting Plant and Borrow Money Outside the Debt Limit Therefor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The city of Boston, by a two thirds vote of the
2 city council with the approval of the mayor, may
3 establish a municipal lighting plant, without comply-
4 ing with section thirty-five of chapter one hundred
5 and sixty-four of the General Laws, and without
6 acquiring under said chapter any privately owned
7 lighting plant in said city. For the purpose of estab-
8 lishing such lighting plant said city may incur in-
9 debtedness beyond the limit set by law to an amount
10 not exceeding the present assessed value of sixty-
11 three million dollars.
