The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

Resolve providing for the Compiling, Printing and Distribution of the Criminal Laws of the Commonwealth.

1 *Resolved*, That the attorney general shall cause
2 the criminal laws of the commonwealth to be com-
3 piled, indexed and annotated, and shall cause to be
4 printed in pamphlet form an edition of not more
5 than fifteen thousand copies of such compilation.
6 Said copies shall be sold under the direction of the
7 secretary of the commonwealth at a price not less
8 than the cost thereof. To carry out the provisions
9 of this resolve, there may be expended such amount,
10 not exceeding dollars, as the general
11 court may appropriate.
