## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act relative to Use of Trust Funds for Cemetery Purposes by Overseers of Monthly Meetings of Friends or Quakers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section ten of chapter sixty-eight of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary edition  
3 thereof, is hereby amended by adding at the end of  
4 the section the following:—

5 Such corporation may hold funds in trust and apply  
6 the income thereof to the improvement or embellish-  
7 ment of any cemetery owned or controlled by it or  
8 to the care, preservation or embellishment of any lot  
9 or its appurtenances.
