The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

Resolutions favoring the Participation by Certain Towns of the Commonwealth in the Benefits provided by the Federal Emergency Relief Administration.

1 *Resolved*, That The General Court of Massachusetts
2 hereby requests the Administrator of the Federal
3 Emergency Relief Administration at Washington,
4 D. C., to grant money to towns of this Common-
5 wealth, irrespective of population, for the carrying
6 out by said towns of unemployment relief projects,
7 and requests the Massachusetts Administrator of
8 said administration to exercise whatever discretionary
9 powers he may have with respect to the granting of
10 money under said administration to towns for the
11 carrying out of projects as aforesaid so that towns of
12 the Commonwealth of less than five thousand in-
13 habitants will not be deprived of such grants of
14 money; and be it further

15 *Resolved*, That the Secretary of the Commonwealth
16 forthwith send copies of these Resolutions to the

17 President of the United States, the Federal Emer-
18 gency Relief Administrator at Washington, D. C.,
19 the Massachusetts Administrator of the Federal
20 Emergency Relief Administration and to the members
21 of Congress from this Commonwealth.
