Resolve providing for the Compiling, Printing and Distribution of the Criminal Laws of the Commonwealth.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public safety shall  
2 cause the criminal laws of the commonwealth to be  
3 compiled, indexed and annotated, and shall cause to  
4 be printed in pamphlet form an edition of not more  
5 than fifteen thousand copies of such compilation.  
6 Said copies shall be sold under the direction of the  
7 secretary of the commonwealth at a price not less than  
8 the cost thereof. For the aforesaid purpose, there  
9 may be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the  
10 commonwealth such sum, not exceeding two thousand  
11 dollars, as may hereafter be appropriated.
