By Messrs. James J. Sullivan and Havey of Boston, petition of Herbert J. Connors, James J. Sullivan and Clayton L. Havey for extension of the rapid transit system of the Boston Elevated Railway Company from Forest Hills to Spring Street in the West Roxbury District. Metropolitan Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act providing for the Extension of the Rapid Transit System to the West Roxbury District of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The transit department of the city of Boston shall
2 extend the rapid transit system of the Boston Elevated
3 Railway Company from the Forest Hills station in the
4 city of Boston to Spring street in the West Roxbury
5 district of said city, following generally the existing
6 location of the West Roxbury branch of the New York,
7 New Haven and Hartford Railroad, as shown on a
8 plan prepared by the division of metropolitan planning,
9 entitled "Proposed Rapid Transit Extension to West
10 Roxbury" and numbered "157-10".
