

HOUSE No. 1538

By Mr. Nagle of Boston, petition of Edward J. Carey and others for removal of certain restrictions relative to sale of alcoholic beverages on or near a specified portion of the Nantasket Beach Reservation. Legal Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act removing Certain Restrictions relative to the Sale of Intoxicating Liquor on or near a Certain Portion of the Nantasket Beach Reservation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section three of chapter four hundred
2 and sixty-four of the acts of eighteen hundred and
3 ninety-nine is hereby amended by striking out all
4 after the word "enjoyment" in the sixth line and
5 inserting in place thereof the following:— Licenses
6 may be granted for the sale of alcoholic beverages
7 in so much of that portion of Nantasket Beach
8 taken under the provisions of this act as is shown
9 on a plan marked "Commonwealth of Massachu-
10 setts, Metropolitan Park Commission, Nantasket
11 Beach Reservation, Plan of Taking Southeasterly
12 from Otis St., Hull, Mass., March 3, 1900, Wm. T.
13 Pierce, Engineer," being metropolitan park com-

14 missioners plan No. 269, and is bounded and de-
15 scribed as follows:— Beginning at a stake at the
16 point of intersection of mean high water mark of
17 Massachusetts bay as shown on said plan with the
18 northwesterly boundary line of the second parcel
19 described in a prior taking by said commissioners
20 dated March seventh, nineteen hundred, and re-
21 corded with Plymouth Deeds on March twelfth,
22 nineteen hundred, accompanied by plan marked
23 “Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Metropolitan
24 Park Commission, Nantasket Beach Reservation,
25 Plan of Taking, Northwesterly from Atlantic Hill,
26 Hull, Mass., March 3, 1900, Wm. T. Pierce, Engi-
27 neer” being metropolitan park commissioners plan
28 No. 267; thence south $51^{\circ} 37' 0''$ west by said bound-
29 ary line, one hundred forty-eight (148) feet, more
30 or less, to a stake at the point of intersection of the
31 same with the northeasterly side line of the location
32 of the New York, New Haven and Hartford rail-
33 road as shown on said plan No. 269 of said commis-
34 sioners to be recorded herewith; thence north-
35 westerly curving to the left on a radius of nineteen
36 hundred twenty-one and ninety-seven hundredths
37 feet by said side line, one hundred twenty-seven
38 and two hundredths feet to a stake; thence north
39 $40^{\circ} 53' 28''$ west by said side line, six hundred ninety-
40 eight and twenty-seven hundredths feet to a stake
41 at an angle in the same, thence north $49^{\circ} 18' 50''$
42 east by said side line, twenty-eight and eighty-three
43 hundredths feet to a stake at an angle in the same;
44 thence northwesterly curving to the right on a
45 radius of eighteen hundred fifty-one and fifty hun-
46 dredths feet by said side line, one hundred fifty
47 and twenty-one one hundredths (150.21) feet to a

48 stake at an angle in the same; thence south 49°
49 $18' 50''$ west by said side line, twenty-two and
50 seventy-one one hundredths (22.71) feet to a stake
51 at an angle in the same; thence north $38^{\circ} 4' 40''$
52 west by said side line, sixty and six hundredths
53 (60.06) feet to a stake at an angle in the same;
54 thence north $49^{\circ} 18' 50''$ east by said side line,
55 twenty-five and eighty-five hundredths (25.85) feet
56 to a stake at an angle in the same; thence north
57 $38^{\circ} 32' 0''$ west by said side line, three hundred and
58 eleven and eighty-eight hundredths (311.88) feet to a
59 stake; thence northwesterly, nearly northerly, curv-
60 ing to the left on a radius of nineteen hundred
61 twenty-two feet by said side line, fifty-one and
62 thirty-one one hundredths (51.31) feet to a stake
63 at an angle in the same; thence south $49^{\circ} 18' 50''$
64 west by said side line, twenty-seven and twenty-
65 four hundredths (27.24) feet to a stake at an angle
66 in the same; thence north $35^{\circ} 26' 10''$ west by said
67 side line, one hundred fifty-one and sixty-eight
68 hundredths (151.68) feet to a stake at an angle in
69 the same; thence north $49^{\circ} 18' 50''$ east by said
70 side line, thirty-four and twenty-two hundredths
71 (34.22) feet to a stake at an angle in the same;
72 thence northwesterly curving to the left on a radius
73 of nineteen hundred twenty-two feet by said side
74 line one hundred thirty-nine and five hundredths
75 (139.05) feet to a stake at an angle in the same;
76 thence south $49^{\circ} 18' 50''$ west by said side line,
77 twenty-nine and ninety-six hundredths (29.96) feet
78 to a stake at an angle in the same; thence north
79 $36^{\circ} 47' 55''$ west by said side line, two hundred one
80 and ten hundredths (201.10) feet to a stake at an
81 angle in the same; thence north $49^{\circ} 13' 7''$ east

82 by said side line, fifteen and forty-five hundredths
83 (15.45) feet to a stake at an angle in the same;
84 thence north $41^{\circ} 15' 58''$ west by said side line,
85 fifty (50) feet to a stake in the same at land of E. E.
86 Hobart; thence north $49^{\circ} 13' 7''$ east through said
87 land, eighty-six (86) feet, more or less, to a stake
88 at the point of intersection of the same with the
89 mean high water mark of said Massachusetts bay
90 as shown on said plan No. 269 of said commissioners;
91 thence in a general southeasterly direction by said
92 mean high water mark as the same bends and
93 curves, nineteen hundred and forty-four (1,944) feet,
94 more or less, to the stake at the point of intersec-
95 tion of the same with the northwesterly boundary
96 line of said prior taking by said commissioners, being
97 the point of beginning. Together with all lands,
98 thatch and flats that lie adjacent to the parcel
99 above described, between said mean high water mark
100 and extreme low water line of said Massachusetts
101 bay, and between the side lines of said parcel ex-
102 tended according to law to said extreme low water
103 line.

1 SECTION 2. Except as hereinbefore provided, no
2 licenses shall be granted for the sale of alcoholic
3 beverages in any buildings or place within four
4 hundred feet of that portion of Nantasket beach
5 taken under the provisions of this act.
