## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act relative to the Election of Commissioners to apportion Suffolk County into Representative Districts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section one hundred and sixty-one of chapter fifty-  
2 four of the General Laws, as appearing in the Ter-  
3 centenary edition thereof, is hereby amended by  
4 striking out, in the seventh line, the word “twenty-  
5 four”, and by inserting in place thereof the word:—  
6 thirty-four,—and by striking out all after the word  
7 “it” in the eighth line down to and including the word  
8 “twenty-four” in the fourteenth line and inserting in  
9 place thereof the following:—First district, wards  
10 one, two, three. Second district, wards four, five,  
11 twenty-one, twenty-two. Third district, wards six,  
12 seven, eight, nine, ten, eleven. Fourth district, wards  
13 twelve, fourteen, nineteen, twenty. Fifth district,  
14 wards thirteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen,—  
15 so that the first paragraph of said section will read as  
16 follows:—At the biennial state election in nineteen  
17 hundred and twenty-four, and in every tenth year  
18 thereafter, nine commissioners shall be elected to ap-  
19 portion Suffolk county into representative districts  
20 under section five of chapter fifty-seven. For the

21 purpose of electing commissioners as aforesaid, the  
22 city of Boston is hereby divided into the five following  
23 districts, each comprising the territory within the  
24 wards, as constituted on January first, nineteen hun-  
25 dred and thirty-four, which are hereinafter assigned  
26 to it: First district, wards one, two, three. Second  
27 district, wards four, five, twenty-one, twenty-two.  
28 Third district, wards six, seven, eight, nine, ten, eleven.  
29 Fourth district, wards twelve, fourteen, nineteen,  
30 twenty. Fifth district, wards thirteen, fifteen, sixteen,  
31 seventeen, eighteen.
