Substituted by the House, on motion of Mr. Dean of Chilmark, for the Bill enabling the Commonwealth and the county of Dukes County to build a bridge and approaches over the outlet of Lagoon Pond between the towns of Oak Bluffs and Tisbury, and for such purpose to secure certain benefits provided by the National Industrial Recovery Act (House, No. 1483, amended). May 23.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act authorizing the County of Dukes County to borrow Money for the Purpose of Contributing to the Cost of Constructing a Bridge and Approaches Thereto over the Outlet of Lagoon Pond between the Towns of Oak Bluffs and Tisbury and of Certain Dredging in Connection Therewith.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of contributing to the
2 cost of the construction by the state department of
3 public works of a bridge, with approaches thereto,
4 over the outlet of Lagoon pond between the towns of
5 Oak Bluffs and Tisbury and to the cost of the dredging
6 by said department of a channel under said bridge,
7 the county commissioners for the county of Dukes
8 County may from time to time borrow upon the credit
9 of the county such sums as may be necessary, not

10 exceeding, in the aggregate, forty thousand dollars,
11 and may issue bonds or notes of the county therefor,
12 which shall bear on their face the words, Dukes
13 County Bridge Loan, Act of 1934. Each authorized
14 issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such loans
15 shall be payable in not more than ten years from their
16 dates. Such bonds or notes shall be signed by the
17 treasurer of the county and countersigned by a
18 majority of the county commissioners. The county
19 may sell the said securities at public or private sale
20 upon such terms and conditions as the county com-
21 missioners may deem proper, but not for less than their
22 par value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder shall,
23 except as herein provided, be subject to chapter thirty-
24 five of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. The town of Gosnold shall not be re-
2 quired to pay any part of the expense incurred by said
3 county hereunder or in caring for and maintaining the
4 said bridge.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance during the current year by the county com-
3 missioners of said county, but not otherwise.
