## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

An Act transferring a Portion of the Proceeds of the Gasoline Tax from the Highway Fund to the General Fund.

1    *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would  
2 tend to defeat its purpose, therefore it is hereby de-  
3 clared to be an emergency law, necessary for the  
4 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1    The state treasurer is hereby authorized and  
2 directed to transfer the sum of ten million dollars  
3 from the Highway Fund to the General Fund.
