## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

---

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

---

An Act re-establishing the Salaries or Other Compensation of Officers and Employees of the Commonwealth and of Certain Counties.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act  
2 would cause substantial inconvenience, therefore it  
3 is hereby declared to be an emergency law, neces-  
4 sary for the immediate preservation of the public  
5 convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and five of  
2 the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-three is  
3 hereby amended by striking out section five and  
4 inserting in place thereof the following:—

5 *Section 5.* The reduction in salaries provided  
6 for by this act shall be effective only for the  
7 period beginning April first and ending November  
8 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and thirty-three, except  
9 that the reduction in salaries of the members of

10 the general court shall be effective as of the first  
11 Wednesday in January and shall continue only  
12 until the end of the legislative year of nineteen  
13 hundred and thirty-three.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter one hundred and eighty-  
2 six of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-  
3 three is hereby amended by striking out section  
4 five and inserting in place thereof the following: —  
5 *Section 5.* The reduction in salaries provided  
6 for by this act shall be effective only for the period  
7 beginning May first and ending December thirty-  
8 first, nineteen hundred and thirty-three.

1 SECTION 3. Section one of this act shall take  
2 effect as of November thirtieth, nineteen hundred  
3 and thirty-three, and section two of this act shall  
4 take effect as of December thirty-first, nineteen  
5 hundred and thirty-three.
