The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Four.

Resolve providing for the Erection in Saratoga, New York, of a Monument or Other Suitable Memorial in Commemoration of Massachusetts Citizens who fought in the Battle of Saratoga.

1 *Resolved*, That a special unpaid commission, to
2 consist of five persons to be appointed by the
3 governor, with the advice and consent of the council,
4 is hereby established, who shall, if authorized thereto
5 by the State of New York, erect in the city of
6 Saratoga in said state, on land owned by said state,
7 a monument or other suitable memorial, approved
8 by the governor and council, in commemoration of
9 Massachusetts citizens who fought in the battle of
10 Saratoga, so-called. The commission shall be pro-
11 vided with quarters in the state house, may travel
12 outside the commonwealth, or authorize any em-
13 ployee or assistant so to travel, and may expend
14 for clerical, expert and other expenses, from such
15 amount, not exceeding five thousand dollars, as
