To accompany the petition of John S. Sullivan that Richard I. Nordstrom of Worcester be compensated for certain injuries received by him while in the performance of his duties as private of Company D. 181st Infantry, Massachusetts National Guard. Ways and Means.

Resolve in Favor of Richard I. Nordstrom.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging
2 the moral obligation of the commonwealth in the
3 premises, and after an appropriation has been made,
4 there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of
5 the commonwealth to Richard I. Nordstrom of
6 Worcester, formerly a private in company D of the
7 one hundred and eighty-first infantry, Massachusetts
8 national guard, who suffered a leg injury at Fort
9 Devens on July twenty-second, nineteen hundred
10 and thirty-one, in the course of duty, the sum of
11 dollars, which sum, in addition to the
12 sum of three hundred and twelve dollars already
13 awarded to him for said injury by the board on
14 claims for physical injuries, shall be in full com-
15 pensation for said injury.
